The Social Security (Contributions, Re-rating) Consequential Amendment Regulations 1985

Made - - - - - 5th February 1985 Laid before Parliament 14th February 1985 Coming into Operation 6th April 1985

The Secretary of State for Social Services in exercise of powers conferred upon him by section 129(1) of the Social Security Act 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, by this instrument, which contains only provisions in consequence of the Social Security (Contributions, Re-rating) (No. 2) Order 1984(b), for the purpose of making provision consequential on that order, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Contributions, Re-rating) Consequential Amendment Regulations 1985 and shall come into operation on 6th April 1985 immediately after the coming into operation of the Social Security (Contributions, Re-rating) (No. 2) Order 1984.

Amendment of regulation 98 of the Social Security (Contributions) Regulations 1979

2. In regulation 98(c) of the Social Security (Contributions) Regulations 1979(c) (modification in relation to share fishermen of Part I of the Act and so much of Part IV thereof as relates to contributions) for "£7.20" there shall be substituted "£7.55".
