**The Motor Vehicles (Type Approval and Approval Marks)
(Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1985**

Made - - - 30th October 1985

Laid before Parliament 11th November 1985

Coming into Operation 2nd December 1985

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 50(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1972(a) and now vested in him (b), and of the powers conferred by section 56(1) of the Finance Act 1973(c) with the consent of the Treasury, and of all other enabling powers, and in relation to the exercise of the powers conferred by section 50(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1972, after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with section 199(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 2nd December 1985 and may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval and Approval Marks) (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1985.

2. The Motor Vehicles (Type Approval and Approval Marks) (Fees) Regulations 1984(d) are hereby amended in Regulation 11 by the substitution for the words “Great Britain”, wherever they occur, of the words “United Kingdom”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval and Approval Marks) (Fees) Regulations 1984 by providing that additional fees are payable in respect of a visit to a place outside the United Kingdom, and not in respect of a visit to a place in Northern Ireland, which is outside Great Britain but within the United Kingdom.
