**The Race Relations (Prescribed Public Bodies) (Amendment)
(No. 2) Regulations 1985**

The Minister for the Civil Service, in exercise of the powers conferred on her by section 75(5)(a) of the Race Relations Act 1976(a), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Race Relations (Prescribed Public Bodies) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1985, and shall come into operation on 9th December 1985.

2. The Schedule to the Race Relations (Prescribed Public Bodies) Regulations 1984(b) shall be amended by the substitution for the words “National Museum of Antiquities of Scotland” of the words “National Museums of Scotland”.

 EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

Section 1 of the National Heritage (Scotland) Act 1985 (c.16) provides for the establishment of a Board of Trustees of the National Museums of Scotland. These Regulations maintain the exemptions under the Race Relations Act 1976 previously enjoyed by the bodies now comprised in the National Museums, these being the National Museum of Antiquities of Scotland (exempted by Regulations under section 75(5)(a) of that Act) and the Royal Scottish Museum (previously exempted as part of the Scottish Office).
