The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 128 of the County Courts Act 1984(a), with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the County Court Fees (Amendment No. 2) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 30th December 1985.
 - 2. The County Court Fees Order 1982(b) shall be amended as follows:—
 - (a) In Fee 2A(i) in Schedule 1 to the said Order of 1982, after the words "to the judge", there shall be inserted the words "from the registrar";
 - (b) For Fee 7 in the said Schedule there shall be substituted the following fee:—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the County Court Fees Order 1982, as amended, so as—

- (a) to make it clear that the fee payable on appeals relates to appeals from the registrar (Article 2(a));
- (b) to delete two fees payable at the Registry of County Court Judgments, which will be fixed under section 73(5) of the County Courts Act 1984 while the Register is kept by a body under contract to the Lord Chancellor pursuant to section 54 of the Administration of Justice Act 1985 (c. 61) (Article 2(b)).
