LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND AND WALES CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Shropshire (District Boundaries) Order 1985

Made - - - - 3rd December 1985
Laid before Parliament 11th December 1985
Coming into Operation—
for the purposes described in article 2(1)— 1st January 1986
for all other purposes— 1st April 1986

Whereas the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, acting pursuant to sections 47 and 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), has made proposals to the Secretary of State for an alteration in the boundary between the borough of Shrewsbury and Atcham and the district of South Shropshire:

And whereas more than six weeks has elapsed since those proposals were made:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to the proposals:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

- 1. This order may be citied as the Shropshire (District Boundaries) Order 1985.
- 2.—(1) 1st January 1986 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(b).
- (2) For all other purposes, this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1986.

Transfer from Shrewsbury and Atcham to South Shropshire

- 3. That part of the borough of Shrewsbury and Atcham and of the parish of All Stretton which is marked A on the map issued by the Department of the Environment as the "Map of the Shropshire (District Boundaries) Order 1985" shall be transferred to—
 - (a) the district of South Shropshire;

- (b) the Wentnor ward of that district;
- (c) the parish of Ratlinghope;
- (d) the Bishops Castle electoral division of Shropshire; and
- (e) the South Shropshire coroner's district.

Town and Country Planning

4. Any provisions of a local plan adopted by the Shrewsbury and Atcham borough council which apply to the area transferred by article 2 immediately prior to 1st April 1986 shall continue to have effect in relation thereto as if they were part of a plan adopted by the South Shropshire district council.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order transfers a small part of the parish of All Stretton in the borough of Shrewsbury and Atcham to the district of South Shropshire and to the parish of Ratlinghope.

The map forming part of this note (page 3) gives a general indication of the area. Its population is less than 10, and the total rateable value about £450.

Prints of the detailed boundary map referred to in article 3 may be inspected at the offices of the borough and district councils, and may be inspected or purchased at the Department of the Environment's Map Library, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB.

Consequential changes are made to local government electoral areas.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976, mentioned in article 2 (1), contain further provisions about the effect and implementation of orders such as the present one.
