In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 60(3)(c) of the Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1985(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1985 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1985.
2. Section 35 of the Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1985 shall come into force on 1st January 1986.
3. Section 50 of the Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1985 shall come into force on 1st February 1986.
