The Extradition (Taking of Hostages) (Amendment) Order 1985

Made - - - - 18th December 1985
Laid before Parliament 8th January 1986
Coming into Operation 1st February 1986

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 18th day of December 1985

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by sections 2, 17 and 21 of the Extradition Act 1870 **(a)** and section 5(1) of the Taking of Hostages Act 1982 **(b)**, or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Extradition (Taking of Hostages) (Amendment) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1986.

2. The Extradition (Taking of Hostages) Order 1985 **(c)** shall be amended by adding to Schedule 2 (which names the foreign States with which the United Kingdom has extradition treaties in force and which are parties to the International Convention against the Taking of Hostages opened for signature at New York on 18th December 1979 **(d)**) the following entry:—
