The Extradition (Tokyo Convention) (Amendment) Order 1985

Made -18th December 1985 Laid before Parliament 8th January 1986 Coming into Operation 1st February 1986

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 18th day of December 1985

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by sections 2, 17 and 21 of the Extradition Act 1870(a) and section 2(2) of the Tokyo Convention Act 1967(b) or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Extradition (Tokyo Convention) (Amendment) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st February
- 2. The Extradition (Tokyo Convention) Order 1971(c) shall be amended by adding to Schedule 1 (which names the States with which the United Kingdom has extradition treaties and in respect of which the Convention on Offences and certain other Acts Committed on board Aircraft signed at Tokyo on 14th September 1963 (d) is in force) the following entries:

Haiti	7th December 1874	25th July 1984
Monaco	17th December 1891	31st August 1983
