CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Canterbury and Shepway (Areas) Order 1985

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	10th January 1985
<i>Laid before Parliament</i> - -	21st January 1985
<i>Coming into Operation—</i> <i>for the purposes described</i> <i>in article 2(1)</i> - - -	28th February 1985
<i>for all other purposes</i> - -	1st April 1985

Whereas the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, acting pursuant to sections 47 and 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), has made proposals to the Secretary of State for an alteration in the boundary between the city of Canterbury and the district of Shepway:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to those proposals:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Canterbury and Shepway (Areas) Order 1985.

2.— (1) 28th February 1985 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(b).

(2) For all other purposes, this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1985.

Transfer from district to city

3. That part of the district of Shepway and of the parish of Stelling Minnis which is shown coloured yellow on the boundary map issued by the Department of the Environment as the "Map of the Canterbury and Shepway (Areas) Order 1985" shall be transferred—

- (a) to the city of Canterbury and to the parish of Waltham;
- (b) from the Stone Street ward of the district to the Stone Street ward of the city;
- (c) to the Kent county electoral division of Canterbury South;
- (d) to the Canterbury and St Augustine petty sessional division, and to the Canterbury and Dover coroner's district.

Town and Country Planning

4. Any provisions of a local plan adopted by Shepway district council which are applicable to the area transferred by article 3 shall have effect as if they were a local plan adopted by the Canterbury city council.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

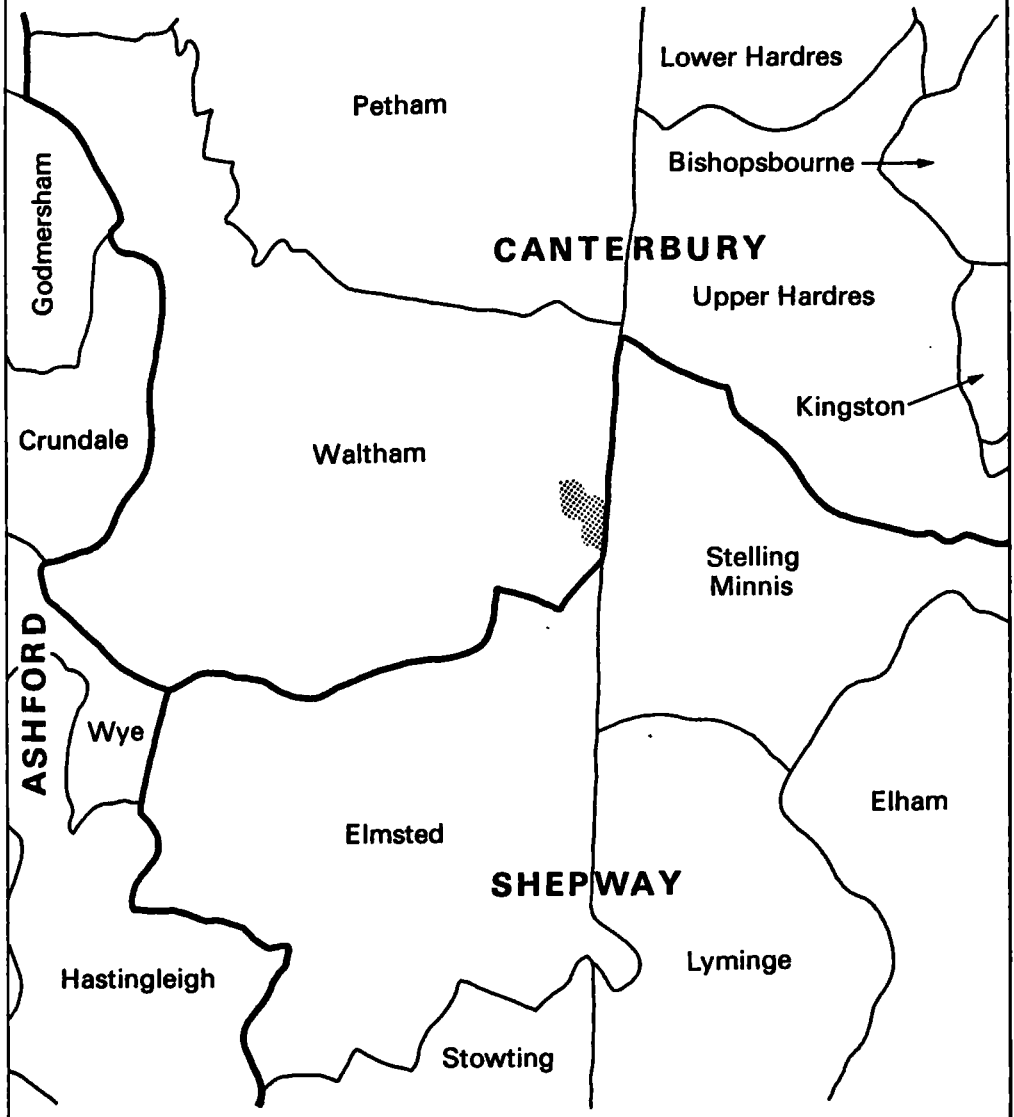
(This note is not part of the order.)

This order transfers the Syngate Wood area of the parish of Stelling Minnis in the district of Shepway to the city of Canterbury and to the parish of Waltham. The map forming part of this note (page 3) gives a general guide to the area affected by this order as from 1st April 1985. Prints of the detailed boundary map, which forms part of the order and is referred to in article 3, may be inspected at the offices of the city and district councils, and may be purchased from the Department of the Environment's Map Library, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1.

Consequential changes in local government electoral areas are made.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976, mentioned in article 2(1), contain further provisions about the effect and implementation of orders such as the present one.
