The Education Support Grants (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1985

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Secretary of State by section 1(2) of the Education (Grants and Awards) Act 1984(a) and after consulting, in accordance with section 3(5) of that Act, such bodies representing local education authorities as appear to them to be appropriate, the Secretary of State for Education and Science, as respects England, and the Secretary of State for Wales, as respects Wales, hereby make the following Regulations, a draft of which has been laid before Parliament and has been approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education Support Grants (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1986.

2. The Schedule to the Education Support Grants Regulations 1984(b) (which specifies the purposes for or in connection with which education support grants are payable) shall be amended by the addition after item 15 of the following item:—

"16. Securing the supervision of pupils in schools at midday."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Education Support Grants Regulations 1984 by adding the additional purpose of securing the supervision of pupils in schools at midday to those in respect of which the Secretary of State may pay grants to local education authorities in respect of expenditure incurred or to be incurred by them.
