CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Cherwell and West Oxfordshire (Areas) Order 1985

Made - - - - - - 10th January 1985

Laid before Parliament - 21st January 1985

Coming into Operation—
for the purposes described in article 2(1) - - - 28th February 1985

for all other purposes - - 1st April 1985

Whereas the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, acting pursuant to sections 47 and 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), has made proposals to the Secretary of State for an alteration in the boundary between the districts of Cherwell and West Oxfordshire:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to those proposals:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

- 1. This order may be cited as the Cherwell and West Oxfordshire (Areas) Order 1985.
- 2.— (1) 28th February 1985 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(b).
- (2) For all other purposes, this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1985.

Changes in areas

- 3. That part of the district of Cherwell and of the parish of Kidlington which is shown coloured pink on the boundary map issued by the Department of the Environment as "Map of the Cherwell and West Oxfordshire (Areas) Order 1985" shall be transferred—
 - (a) to the district of West Oxfordshire and to the parish of Bladon;
 - (b) to the Bladon and Cassington ward of the district of West Oxfordshire, and to the Hanborough electoral division of the county of Oxfordshire.

Town and Country Planning

4. Any provisions applicable to the area transferred by article 3 of any local plan which has been adopted by the Cherwell District Council shall have effect as if they were a local plan adopted by the West Oxfordshire District Council.

EXPLANATORY NOTE


(This note is not part of the order.)

This order transfers part of the parish of Kidlington in the district of Cherwell to the district of West Oxfordshire and to the parish of Bladon.

The map forming part of this note (page 3) give a general guide to the area affected by this order as from 1st April 1985.
