**The Rate Rebate (Disabled Persons) (Scotland)  
Order 1985**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 4(5) of the Rating (Disabled Persons) Act 1978<sup>(a)</sup> (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Rate Rebate (Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1985.

*Rate rebates on special facilities*

2. The rateable value in respect of a special facility to which section 4(2)(e) of the Act applies shall be £80.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This order prescribes £80 to be the rateable value to be allocated to the floor space used by a disabled person for purposes of a wheelchair (the "special facility") (article 2). The Rating (Disabled Persons) Act 1978 originally prescribed a rateable value of £30.
