**The National Health Service (Determination of Districts)  
Amendment Order 1985**

*Made* - - - 14th January 1985

*Laid before Parliament* 21st January 1985

*Coming into Operation* 18th February 1985

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of powers conferred on him by section 8(1) of the National Health Service Act 1977(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the National Health Service (Determination of Districts) Amendment Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 18th February 1985.

*Amendment of order*

2. In Part I of Schedule 1 to the National Health Service (Determination of Districts) Order 1981(b), in column (2), after “South Sefton” there is inserted “(Merseyside)”.
