The Horsham and Mid Sussex (Areas) Order 1985

Whereas the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, acting pursuant to sections 47 and 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), has made proposals to the Secretary of State for alterations in the boundary between the districts of Horsham and Mid Sussex:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to those proposals with a modification:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:---

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Horsham and Mid Sussex (Areas) Order 1985.

2.— (1) 28th February 1985 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Areas Changes Regulations 1976(b).

(2) For all other purposes, this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1985.

Transfers between districts

3. Those parts of the district of Horsham and of the parish of Woodmancote which are marked A1 and A2 on the map issued by the Department of the Environment as the "Map of the Horsham and Mid Sussex (Areas) Order 1985" shall be transferred to the district of Mid Sussex, to the Cuckfield Rural No. 3 electoral division of the county of West Sussex, and to the Mid Sussex petty sessional division.

The area marked A1 shall form part of the parish of Albourne and of the Bolney ward of the Mid Sussex district.

The area marked A2 shall form part of the parish of Poynings and of the Hurstpierpoint ward of the Mid Sussex district.

Town and Country Planning

4. Any provisions of any local plan which has been adopted by the Horsham District Council shall, insofar as they are applicable to an area transferred by article 3, have effect as if they were contained in a local plan adopted by the Mid Sussex District Council.

Land Registration

5. Registration of title to land under the Land Registration Acts 1925 to 1971(a) shall be compulsory on sale in the areas transferred by article 3.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order.)


This order transfers two areas of the parish of Woodmancote in the district of Horsham to the district of Mid Sussex, one to the parish of Albourne and the other to the parish of Poynings.

The map forming part of this note (page 4) gives a general guide to the areas affected by this order. Prints of the detailed boundary map, which forms part of this order and is referred to in article 3, may be inspected at the offices of the district councils, and may be purchased from the Department of the Environment's Map Library, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1.

Consequential changes are made to local government electoral areas.

The obligation to register title to land in the Mid Sussex district is extended to the transferred areas by article 5.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976, mentioned in article 2(1), contain further provisions about the effect and implementation of orders such as the present one.
