The Upper Spey and Associated Waters Protection (Renewal) Order 1985

Coming into Operation

15th March 1985

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 1(7) of the Freshwater and Salmon Fisheries (Scotland) Act 1976(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Upper Spey and Associated Waters Protection (Renewal) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 15th March 1985.

Interpretation

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires—

"freshwater fish" has the same meaning as in section 24(1) of the Salmon and Freshwater Fisheries (Protection) (Scotland) Act 1951(b); and "the 1982 Order" means the Upper Spey and Associated Waters Protection Order 1982(c).

Renewal of order

3. The 1982 Order is hereby renewed.

Prohibition

4. During the period from 15th March 1985 to 6th October 1987, both dates inclusive fishing for or taking freshwater fish in the inland waters in the area prescribed in article 4 of the 1982 Order, without legal right or without written permission from a person having such a right is hereby prohibited.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order renews the Upper Spey and Associated Waters Protection Order 1982 which prohibited fishing for or taking freshwater fish in inland waters in the area prescribed in that order without legal right or without written permission from someone having such a right. The effect of the renewal is that the prohibition has effect from 15th March 1985 to 6th October 1987.

The prescribed area referred to is those parts of the catchment areas of the Rivers Spey, Spean and Tummel lying within Highland and Tayside Regions. The area is illustrated on a map attached to the 1982 Order and is defined by reference to a large scale map which may be inspected at Chesser House, Gorgie Road, Edinburgh on any working day between 8.30 am and 4.30 pm.
