**The Bath—Lincoln Trunk Road (A435) (Evesham) De-Trunking
Order 1985**

Made - - - 13th March 1985

Coming into Operation 21st March 1985

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this order in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The length of trunk road described in the Schedule to this order and shown by broad striped hatching on the deposited plan shall cease to be a trunk road and shall be classified as a principal road as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the County Council of Hereford and Worcester that the new trunk road is open for through traffic.

2. In this order:—

(1) all measurements of distance are measured along the route of the relevant highway;

(2) (i) “principal road” as a classification for a highway, means that the highway is a principal road for the purposes of enactments and instruments which refer to highways classified as principal roads and is also classified for the purpose of every other enactment and instrument which refers to highways classified by the Secretary of State;

(ii) “the deposited plan” means the plan folio numbered HA10/2 WMRO(L) XIX marked “The Bath—Lincoln Trunk Road (A435) (Evesham) De-Trunking Order 1985” containing one plan and signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of Transport, Romney House, Marsham Street, London SW1P 3PY;

(iii) “the new trunk road” means the trunk road to be constructed by the Secretary of State in pursuance of the Bath—Lincoln Trunk Road (A435) (Evesham Bypass) Order 1985(c);

(iv) "the trunk road" means the Bath—Lincoln Trunk Road (A435).

3. This order shall come into operation on 21st March 1985 and may be cited as the Bath—Lincoln Trunk Road (A435) (Evesham) De-Trunking Order 1985.

SCHEDULE

LENGTH OF TRUNK ROAD CEASING TO BE TRUNK ROAD

That length of the Trunk Road which is situated at Evesham in the County of Hereford and Worcester for a distance of 4.57 kilometres (2.84 miles) in a northerly direction from a point (marked A on the deposited plan) 180 metres (197 yards) south of the entrance to Brooklands Farm, Cheltenham Road, Evesham, to a point (marked B on the deposited plan, 20 metres (22 yards) south of the junction with Lenchwick Road, Twyford.
