# The (A66) Stockton Road Interchange Road (Trunking) Order 1985

19th March 1985

Coming into Operation

30th April 1985

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 10 of the Highways Act 1980(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The lengths of existing highway along the routes described in paragraphs 1 and 2 in the Schedule to this Order and shown by black vertical stripes on the deposited plan shall become trunk road as from the date when this Order comes into operation.

#### 2. In this Order-

- (i) all measurements of distance are measured along the route of the relevant highway;
- (ii) "the eastbound carriageway" and "the westbound carriageway" mean respectively the eastbound carriageway and the westbound carriageway of the (A66) Stockton Road Interchange Road; and
- (iii) "the deposited plan" means the plan numbered HA 10/2-/N199 marked "The (A66) Stockton Road Interchange Road (Trunking) Order 1985" signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of Transport, Romney House, Marsham Street, London, SWIP3PY.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on 30th April 1985 and may be cited as the (A66) Stockton Road Interchange Road (Trunking) Order 1985.

#### **SCHEDULE**

#### EXISTING LENGTHS OF HIGHWAY TO BECOME TRUNK ROAD

- 1. That length of the eastbound carriageway of the (A66) Stockton Road Interchange Road extending in an easterly direction from a point 260 metres (284·44 yards) east of the centre of the Old River Tees Bridge to a point 334 metres (365·40 yards) east of the centre of the Old River Tees Bridge, a distance of 74 metres (80·96 yards), in the District of Middlesbrough in the County of Cleveland.
- 2. That length of the westbound carriageway of the (A66) Stockton Road Interchange Road extending in a westerly direction from a point 744 metres (814.07 yards) east of the centre of the Old River Tees Bridge to a point 260 metres (284.44 yards) east of the centre of the Old River Tees Bridge, a distance of 484 metres (528.87 yards), in the District of Middlesbrough in the County of Cleveland.

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
