BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES

The Lotteries (Registration Authority Fees) (Scotland) Order 1985

Made -18th March 1985 Laid before Parliament 2nd April 1985 Coming into Operation 1st May 1985

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 18(1)(d) and 24(2) of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

- 1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Lotteries (Registration Authority Fees) (Scotland) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1985.
 - (2) This order shall extend to Scotland only.
- 2. The fee payable under paragraph 3 of Schedule 1 to the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976 (which makes provision for the registration of a society for the purposes of section 5 of that Act and prescribes a fee payable upon such registration to a registration authority)(b) shall, instead of £20, be £25.
- 3. The fee payable under paragraph 9 of Schedule 1 to the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976 (which provides for an annual fee payable by a society registered under Part I of that Schedule to a registration authority)(c) shall, instead of £10, be £12.50.
- 4. The Lotteries (Registration Authority Fees) (Scotland) Order 1981(d) is hereby revoked.
