TELEGRAPHS

The Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges and Exemption) (Amendment) Regulations 1985

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949(a), as enacted and as extended by the Wireless Telegraphy (Channel Islands) Order 1952(b) and the Wireless Telegraphy (Isle of Man) Order 1952(c), and now vested in him (d), hereby, with the consent of the Treasury, makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges and Exemption) (Amendment) Regulations 1985 and shall come into operation on 28th March 1985.

2. Schedules 3 and 4 to the Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges and Exemption) Regulations 1984(e) shall be amended as follows:—

- (a) for “£15” in each place where it occurs there shall be substituted “£18”,
and
- (b) for “£46” in each place where it occurs there shall be substituted “£58”.
