The National Health Service (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1985

Made	28th March 1985
Laid before Parliament	29th March 1985
Coming into Operation	1st April 1985

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 19, 27, 28 and 108(1) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the National Health Service (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1985.
- (2) In these regulations "Schedule 2A" means Schedule 2A to the National Health Service (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) (Scotland) Regulations 1974(b) (drugs and other substances not to be supplied by general medical practitioners or prescribed for supply under pharmaceutical services).

Amendment of Schedule 2A

- 2.—(1) Schedule 2A shall be amended in accordance with the following paragraphs of this regulation.
- (2) There shall be substituted for the entries in column 1 of the following table the entries in column 2 of that table.

These Regulations correct errors in, and the omission of three drugs or other substances from, Schedule 2A to the National Health Service (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) (Scotland) Regulations 1974, as inserted by the National Health Service (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1985, (which last mentioned Regulations come into force on 1st April 1985). That Schedule lists drugs and other substances which cannot be supplied by doctors or prescribed for supply under pharmaceutical services under the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978.
