**The South West Water Authority
(River Exe/River Taw Transfer and River Taw at Newbridge)
Order 1985**

Made - - - - - 21st May 1985
Coming into Operation 24th May 1985

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the South West Water Authority (River Exe/River Taw Transfer and River Taw at Newbridge) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 24th May 1985.

(2) The South West Water Authority Orders 1974 to 1983 and this order may be cited together as the South West Water Authority Orders 1974 to 1985.

Interpretation

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires, expressions to which meanings are assigned by the Third Schedule have the same respective meanings; and

“the Authority” means the South West Water Authority;

“the authorised works” means the works authorised by this order;

“the deposited plan” means the plan prepared in duplicate signed by an Under Secretary in the Department of the Environment and marked “Plans referred to in the South West Water Authority (River Exe/River Taw Transfer and River Taw at Newbridge) Order 1985” one copy of which is deposited and available for inspection at the principal office of the Authority and the other at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment;

“the Third Schedule” means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945;

“the undertaking” means the water undertaking of the Authority as from time to time authorised by any enactment.

Application of certain provisions of the Third Schedule

3. For the purposes of this order the provisions of the Third Schedule which are specified in column (1) of the Schedule to this order shall, subject to the modifications set out in column (2) thereof, apply to the undertaking and are hereby incorporated with this order.

Power to Construct, Improve and Maintain Works

4. The Authority may, when they have acquired the necessary land or sufficient rights therein—

(1) continue and maintain an intake on the River Exe at Exebridge at NGR SS 933 248 in the Parish of Brushford in the District of West Somerset;

(2) continue and maintain an outfall on the River Yeo at NGR SS 853 259 in the Parish of East Anstey in the District of North Devon;

(3) continue and maintain an intake on the River Taw near Newbridge, Barnstaple at NGR SS 582 261 in the District of North Devon;

(4) continue and maintain a treatment works in part of ordnance survey parcel number 0036 in the Parish of Tawstock in the District of North Devon at NGR SS 580 273 and to extend that treatment works by means of the addition of extra filters, a chemical storage and dosing building, pump house and associated works.

(5) the Authority may at any time after the making of this order within the limits of deviation shown coloured pink on the deposited plan alter the authorised works.

Works to form part of undertaking

5. The works authorised by this order shall for all purposes form part of the undertaking.

SCHEDULE

PROVISIONS OF THE THIRD SCHEDULE APPLIED

Provisions Applied (1)	Modifications (2)
Section 2 (Permissible limits of deviation)	For the words "the plans submitted to the Minister" there shall be substituted the words "the deposited plans", and for the words "the said plans" wherever they occur there shall be substituted the words "the deposited plans".
Section 4 (General power to construct subsidiary works)	The words "and to any other provisions of the special Act limiting the powers of the undertakers to abstract water" shall be omitted; for the words "any land for the time being held by them in connection with their undertaking" there shall be substituted the words "the land described in the special Act" and for the words "their water undertaking" there shall be substituted the words "the authorised works".
Section 94 (Copies of the special Act to be kept by undertakers in their office, and deposited with certain officers)	In subsection (1) for the words from "with the clerk of the council" to the end of the subsection, there shall be substituted the words "with the council of every county and district affected by the special Act".
