**The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Commencement No. 1)
Order 1986**

Made - - - - - *1st July 1986*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by subsections (2) and (3) of section 145 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1986.

2.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) below, section 90 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (approval of radar speed measuring devices) shall come into force on 31st July 1986.

(2) Section 90 shall not have effect in relation to the prosecution of a person for an alleged speeding offence committed before 31st July 1986.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into force on 31st July 1986 section 90 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which provides that, on the prosecution of a person for any speeding offence, evidence of the measurement of any speed by a device designed or adapted for measuring by radar the speed of motor vehicles shall not be admissible unless the device is of a type approved by the Secretary of State. Article 2(2) of the Order provides that section 90 is not to have effect in respect of alleged speeding offences taking place before 31st July 1986. The Radar Speed Measuring Devices Approval (copies of which are available at the offices of HMSO) approved as from 31st July 1986 the following devices: Kustom HR4; Kustom HR8; MPH K15; Muniquip T3; Gatso Mini Radar MK3 and Gatso Mini Radar MK4.

The only provision of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which is not yet in force is paragraph 3 of Schedule 8 (statutory statement of facts). By virtue of section 145(1), all the provisions of the Act (other than section 90 and paragraph 3 of Schedule 8) came into force on 26th September 1984.
