The Anglesey Marine Terminal Act 1972 (Exemption from Cessation) Order 1986

The Secretary of State for Wales in exercise of his powers under section 262(9)(a) of the Local Government Act 1972(a) and of all other enabling powers given him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Anglesey Marine Terminal Act 1972 (Exemption from Cessation) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 11th August 1986.

2. The Anglesey Marine Terminal Act 1972(b) is hereby exempted from cessation under the provisions of section 262(9) of the Local Government Act 1972.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Section 262(9) of the Local Government Act 1972, as extended by the Non-metropolitan and Welsh Counties (Local Statutory Provisions) Order 1983 (S.I. 1983/619) provides that unless exempted by Order made by the Secretary of State under section 262(9)(a) of the 1972 Act a "local statutory provision" as defined in the Act ceases to have effect on 31st December 1986. This Order exempts the Anglesey Marine Terminal Act 1972 from this provision.
