The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by paragraph 17 of Schedule 5A to the Army Act 1955(a), paragraph 17 of Schedule 5A to the Air Force Act 1955(b) and paragraph 17 of Schedule 4A to the Naval Discipline Act 1957(c) hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Courts-Martial and Standing Civilian Courts (Additional Powers on Trial of Civilians) (Amendment) Regulations 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1987.

Amendment

2. Regulation 12(2) of the Courts-Martial and Standing Civilian Courts (Additional Powers on Trial of Civilians) Regulations 1977(d) shall be amended as follows:

- (a) in sub-paragraph (a) for “90” there shall be substituted “240”,
- (b) in sub-paragraph (b) for “30” there shall be substituted “40”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Courts-Martial and Standing Civilian Courts (Additional Powers on Trial of Civilians) Regulations 1977 as follows:—

1. The maximum number of hours of work which may be required or directed under a Community Supervision Order is raised from 90 to 240.
2. The minimum number of hours of work which may be required or directed under a Community Supervision Order is raised from 30 to 40.
