Amendment No. 4 Order 1986**

Whereas the Secretary of State is of the opinion, in accordance with section 1(1)(a) of the Food and Environment Protection Act 1985(a), that there has been or may have been an escape of substances of such descriptions and in such quantities and such circumstances as are likely to create a hazard to human health through human consumption of food;

And whereas the Secretary of State is of the opinion, in accordance with section 1(1)(b) of the said Act, that in consequence of the said escape of substances food which is or may be in the future in the area described in the Schedule to the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Wales) Order 1986(b), or which is derived or may be in the future derived from anything in that area, is, or may be, or may become, unsuitable for human consumption;

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the said section 1(1) and 24(3) of the said Act, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Wales) Amendment No. 4 Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 12th September 1986.

Partial revocation and amendment

2. The Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Wales) Order 1986 is

revoked to the extent that it imposes prohibitions in respect of sheep which are in the area described in article 4 of this order on 12th September 1986; and accordingly that order is further amended in accordance with the following provisions of this order.

3. After article 8 there shall be inserted the following article—

“9. Article 4, 5 and 6 of this order shall not apply in the case of any sheep which was in that part of the designated area described in paragraph 3 of Schedule 2 to this order on 12th September 1986.”.

4. In Schedule 2 there shall be inserted, after paragraph 2, the following paragraph—

“Area excepted from restrictions on 12th September 1986

3. An area comprising those parts of the designated area that lie within the following boundaries:

(1) From where the A4085 road crosses Afon Gwyrfai at OS map ref SH 571532 generally north-westwards along the A4085 road to where it crosses the Afon Gwyrfai at OS map ref SH 568540; generally south-eastwards along the course of Afon Gwyrfai to where it crosses the A4085 road at OS map ref SH 571532.

(2) From the crossing of the A5(T) road with Afon Gwrysgog at OS map ref SH 832523; and then generally north-eastwards following the course of Afon Gwrysgog to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 835526; generally north-westwards along the unmarked road through Capel Siloam to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 832533, then generally westwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 827532; generally northwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 823542, then generally north-eastwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the B5113 road at Nebo; north-westwards along the B5113 road to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 827577; generally north-westwards along the unmarked road to the junction with the B5427 road at OS map SH 814598; generally north-westwards along the B5427 road to the junction with the unmarked road leading to Melin-y-Coed at OS map ref SH 812603 then generally northwards along the unmarked road through Melin-y-Coed, Bryndyffryn to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 823619, eastwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the B5113 road at OS map ref SH 837619; southwards along the B5113 road to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 836588; generally north-eastwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the unmarked road near Bryn-y-Clochydd at OS map ref SH 875607; generally southwards along the unmarked road to its crossing with Afon Cledwen near Tŷ-Drâw at OS map ref SH 870590; generally south-eastwards along the course of Afon Cledwen and then along the course of the stream until it meets a fence at OS map ref SH 881756; generally westwards along the fence to Moel Seisiog at OS map ref SH 862573; generally southwards along the fence following the County boundary until it meets the B5113 road at OS map ref SH 852538; generally south-eastwards along the B5113 road passing through Ty'n y Llidiart, Maes Gwyn to its junction with the A5(T) and unmarked roads at Pentrefoelas; generally south-eastwards along the

unmarked road to its junction with the unmarked road near Penlan at OS map ref SH 876511; generally eastwards then south-eastwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 889505; generally westwards along the unmarked road passing Plâs Idyn and Bryn-Gwyn to its junction with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 863498; generally south-westwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the B4407 and unmarked roads at Ysbyty Ifan; generally north-westwards along the unmarked road passing Ty Mawr, Tai'n y Maes and Dylasau Uchaf to its crossing with Afon Conwy at OS map ref SH 828524; generally north-westwards along the course of Afon Conwy to the crossing with the A5(T) road at Waterloo Bridge near Betws y Coed; generally south-eastwards along the A5(T) road to its crossing with the A5(T) road with Afon Gwrysgog at OS map ref SH 832523.

(3) From the junction of the unmarked roads south-west of Cerrigydrudion at OS map ref SH 949485; generally south-westwards along the unmarked road passing Tai'n-y-rhos crossing Afon Ceirw to its junction with an unmarked road at OS map ref SH 931457; generally eastwards along the unmarked road passing Hendre Ucha to its junction with the B4501 road near Bryn Ffynnon; generally south-westwards along the B4501 road to its junction with the unmarked road near Nant y Cyrtiau; generally north-westwards along the unmarked road passing Hafod-yr-Esgob and Defaidty Cottage to where it meets a fence at OS map ref SH 907454; generally eastwards along the fence to OS map ref SH 915453; generally northwards along the fence to where it meets Afon Ceirw at OS map ref SH 918472; generally south-westwards along Afon Ceirw then Afon Nant-Fach to its crossing with an unmarked road at OS map ref SH 909469; then generally westwards along the unmarked road to its junction with an unmarked road at OS map ref SH 903467; generally north-westwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the unmarked road near Tyn-y-rhos at OS map ref SH 897473; generally north-eastwards along the unmarked road passing Pengwern, Cappel, Bwlch-y-mawn and Swch y Llan to its junction with the unmarked roads south-west of Cerrigydrudion at OS map ref SH 949485.

(4) From the junction of the unmarked road with the A4212 road at OS map ref SH 920368 generally south-eastwards along the A4212 road to the junction with the unmarked road (Craig-y-Fron Road) opposite the College to the north of Bala; westwards and then south-eastwards along the unmarked road (known as Craig-y-Fron Road, Heol y Castell and then Cambrian Terrace) to the junction with the A494 road as far as the pier on Llyn Tegid at OS map ref SH 919355; south-eastwards along a straight imaginary line drawn to OS map ref SH 929352 where the B4391 road crosses Afon Dyfrdwy, generally southwards along the B4391 road to its junction with the B4403 road at OS map ref SH 930350, south-westwards along the B4403 road and then north-westwards through Llanuwchllyn to its junction with the A494(T) road; south-westwards along the A494(T) road to its junction with an unmarked road at OS map ref SH 860287; north-eastwards along the unmarked road to where it meets a fence at OS map ref SH 866299; following the fence generally westwards to OS map ref SH 849295; then northwards to where it meets a track at OS map ref SH 845309; then north-eastwards to Afon Lliw, crossing Afon Lliw to join the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 851312; generally north-westwards along the unmarked road to Buarth Meini at OS map ref SH 829325; then generally north-eastwards following a fence to meet the forest at OS map ref SH 832328; following the fence around the forest generally north then eastwards until it meets an unmarked road at its crossing point of Afon Dylo at OS map

ref SH 855341, then generally northwards along a fence to join Afon Llafar at OS map ref SH 858352; generally north-westwards following the course of the Afon Llafar to OS map ref SH 854355; then northwards along a fence to OS map ref SH 855357; eastwards to OS map ref SH 857357, northwards to OS map ref SH 856361, north-westwards to OS map ref SH 849365, northwards to join Nant Hir at OS map ref SH 849368; following the course of Nant Hir south-eastwards to join an unmarked road at OS map ref SH 860360 where it joins a stream; south-eastwards following the course of the stream to join an unmarked road at OS map ref SH 877356, generally north-eastwards to its junction with an unmarked road at OS map ref SH 886377, generally north-westwards along the unmarked road to its junction with an unmarked road at OS map ref SH 878381; generally eastwards then south-eastwards along the unmarked road to its junction with an unmarked road at OS map ref SH 893378; generally south-eastwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the A4212 road at OS map ref SH 920368.

(5) From the junction of the B4391 road with the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 935350 generally eastwards and then south-eastwards along the B4391 road to OS map ref SJ 018306 where it is met by a fence following the County boundary; generally westwards and then south-westwards along the fence following the County Boundary to where it meets a fence along an unmarked road at OS map ref SH 946270, generally northwards along the unmarked road passing Maesafallen and Aber-Hirnant to its junction at Rhos-y-gwaliau with an unmarked road; westwards along the unmarked road crossing Afon Hirnant and then generally northwards along the unmarked road at OS map ref SH 943348; westwards along the unmarked road to its junction with the B4391 road at OS map ref SH 935350.

The area excludes any part of a road, footpath or body of water by reference to which its boundary is defined.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Wales) Order 1986 (“the principal order”), as amended by S.I. 1986/1435, 1483 and 1535, contains emergency prohibitions restricting various activities in order to prevent human consumption of food which has been or which may have been rendered unsuitable for that purpose in consequence of the escape of radioactive substances from a nuclear reactor situated at Chernobyl in the USSR.

This order excepts from the restrictions imposed by the principal order those sheep which were in that part of the designated area described in article 4 on 12th September 1986; in consequence any sheep which have been moved from that area before that date remain subject to the restrictions imposed by the principal order and, in particular, may not be slaughtered, anywhere in the United Kingdom, for human consumption or for use in the preparation of feeding stuffs.

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
