LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND AND WALES CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Shropshire (District Boundaries) Order 1986

Made	17th September 1986
Laid before Parliament	30th September 1986
Coming into Operation—	
for the purposes described in article 2(1)	31st October 1986
for all other purposes	1st April 1987

Whereas the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, acting pursuant to sections 47 and 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a) has made proposals to the Secretary of State for alterations in the boundaries between the borough of Shrewsbury and Atcham and the district of The Wrekin:

And whereas more than six weeks has elapsed since those proposals were made:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to the proposals:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

- 1. This order may be cited as the Shropshire (District Boundaries) Order 1986.
- 2.—(1) 31st October 1986 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (b).
- (2) For all other purposes, this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1987.

Transfer from the district of The Wrekin to the borough of Shrewsbury and Atcham

- 3. That part of the district of The Wrekin and the parish of Wrockwardine which is shown coloured yellow on the map issued by the Department of the Environment as the "Map of the Shropshire (District Boundaries) Order 1986" shall be transferred to—
 - (a) the borough of Shrewsbury and Atcham;
 - (b) the Attingham ward of that borough;
 - (c) the parish of Wroxeter and Uppington;
 - (d) the Tern electoral division of the county of Shropshire;
 - (e) the Shrewsbury petty sessional division; and
 - (f) the Mid and North-West Shropshire coroner's district.

Town and Country Planning

4. Any provisions of a local plan adopted by The Wrekin District Council which apply to the area transferred by article 3 immediately before 1st April 1987 shall continue to have effect in relation thereto as if they were part of such a plan adopted by the Shrewsbury and Atcham Borough Council.

Land registration

5. Registration of title to land under the Land Registration Acts 1925 to 1986 (a) shall cease to be compulsory on sale in the area transferred by article 3 save insofar as section 154(1) of the Housing Act 1985 (b) applies to any dwelling house situated in that area.

This order transfers a small area of the district of The Wrekin and the parish of Wrockwardine to the borough of Shrewsbury and Atcham and the parish of Wroxeter and Uppington on 1st April 1987.


This map forming part of this note (page 4) gives a general guide to the area affected.

The area transferred has approximately an area of 8.33 hectares, a population of 15 and a rateable value of £705.

Consequential changes to local government electoral areas are made.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976, mentioned in article 2(1), contain further provisions about the effect and implementation of orders such as the present one.
