**The Borough of Taunton Deane (Electoral Arrangements)
Order 1986**

Made - - - - - *7th November 1986*

Coming into operation in accordance with Article 2

Whereas in pursuance of section 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972^(a), the Local Government Boundary Commission for England on 19th July 1985 submitted to me proposals for the future electoral arrangements for the Borough of Taunton Deane:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by sections 51(2) and 67 of that Act, I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Taunton Deane (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1986.

2. This Order shall come into operation on 7th May 1987, except that for the purpose of all proceedings preliminary or relating to an election to be held on or after that day it shall come into operation forthwith.

3.—(1) The existing wards of the Borough of Taunton Deane shall be abolished and that borough shall be divided into thirty wards which shall bear the names set out in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order, and each such ward shall comprise the existing areas specified opposite thereto in column 2 of that Schedule.

(2) The number of councillors to be elected for each ward constituted by paragraph (1) above shall be the number specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order opposite to the name of the ward as given in column 1 of that Schedule.

4. Where a boundary is described in Schedule 1 to this Order as running along a road, railway line, footway, waterway or other similar geographical feature, it shall be treated as running along the centre line thereof.

5. The ordinary elections of all councillors for the Borough of Taunton Deane shall be held simultaneously on the ordinary day of election of non-metropolitan district councillors in 1987 and every fourth year thereafter.

6. The registration officer shall make such re-arrangement or alteration of the register of local government electors as may be necessary on account of the coming into operation of this Order.
