**The Medicines (Stilbenes and Thyrostatic Substances)
(Amendment) Regulations 1986**

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State being Ministers designated (a) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 (b) in relation to the common agricultural policy of the Economic Community and in relation to medicinal products, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the said section 2(2), hereby make the following regulations:—

Title, commencement and extent

1. These regulations may be cited as the Medicines (Stilbenes and Thyrostatic Substances) (Amendment) Regulations 1986 and shall come into operation on 18th December 1986.

Amendment of principal regulations

2. In regulation 4 of the Medicines (Stilbenes and Thyrostatic Substances) Regulations 1982 (c) for “£1,000” there shall be substituted “£2,000”.
