The Medicines (Exemptions from Restrictions on the Retail Sale or Supply of Veterinary Drugs) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1986

<i>Made - - - -</i>	19th November 1986
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	1st December 1986

The Secretary of State concerned with health in England, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health and with agriculture in Scotland and in Wales, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, and the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 57(1), (2), (2A) and 129(4) of the Medicines Act 1968 (a) and now vested in them (b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consulting such organisations as appear to them to be representative of interests likely to be substantially affected by the following order in accordance with section 129(6) of the said Act, and with the consent of the Treasury, hereby make the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Medicines (Exemptions from Restrictions on the Retail Sale or Supply of Veterinary Drugs) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1987.

Amendment of principal order

2. The Medicines (Exemptions from Restrictions on the Retail Sale or Supply of Veterinary Drugs) Order 1985 (c) shall be amended as follows—

- (a) in article 3(11)(b) for “£95.00” there shall be substituted “£88.00”;
- (b) in article 5(10)(b) for “£30.00” there shall be substituted “£29.00”;
- (c) for Schedule 1 there shall be substituted the provisions set out in Schedule 1 to this order;
- (d) for Part B of Schedule 2 there shall be substituted the provisions set out in Schedule 2 to this order; and
- (e) for Part B of Schedule 3 there shall be substituted the provisions set out in Schedule 3 to this order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order further amends the Medicines (Exemptions from Restrictions on the Retail Sale or Supply of Veterinary Drugs) Order 1985.

Paragraph (a) of Article 2 reduces from £95 to £88 the fee payable by a merchant in veterinary drugs under Article 3(11)(b) of that order in respect of each premises for which he seeks to have his name retained in the relevant register.

Paragraph (b) of Article 2 reduces from £30 to £29 the fee payable by a merchant in horse wormers under Article 5(10)(b) of that order in respect of each premises for which he seeks to have his name retained in the relevant register.

Paragraphs (c), (d) and (e) of Article 2 substitute updated provisions for Schedule 1, Part B of Schedule 2 and Part B of Schedule 3 to that order. Certain items, which are shown in italics in the new provisions have been added to Schedule 1 and Parts B of Schedules 2 and 3 to the 1985 order, and certain other items have been deleted.
