The Extradition (Tokyo Convention) (Amendment) Order 1986

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by sections 2, 17 and 21 of the Extradition Act 1870(a) and section 93(4) of the Civil Aviation Act 1982(b), or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Extradition (Tokyo Convention) (Amendment) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1987.
- 2. The Extradition (Tokyo Convention) Order 1971(c) shall be amended by adding to Schedule 1 (which names the States with which the United Kingdom has extradition treaties in force and in respect of which the Convention on Offences and certain other Acts Committed on board Aircraft signed at Tokyo on 14th September 1963(d) is in force) the following entry:—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The entry into force on 1st July 1986 of the Extradition Treaty between the United Kingdom and Spain, concluded on 22nd July 1985, has necessitated amendment to the Extradition (Tokyo Convention) Order 1971.

This Order applies the Extradition Acts 1870 to 1935, as amended by the Tokyo Convention Act 1967, to offences committed on board aircraft in flight registered in Spain.
