**The Financial Services Act 1986 (Commencement No. 2)
Order 1986**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 211(1) of the Financial Services Act 1986(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Financial Services Act 1986 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1986.

2. The provisions of the Financial Services Act 1986 specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall come into force for the purposes specified in the second column on 27th November 1986.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into force on 27th November 1986 the provisions of the Financial Services Act 1986 specified in the Schedule to the Order. The provisions brought into force concern the disclosure of information obtained under those provisions of the Companies Act 1985 and the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1986 which relate to the investigation of companies and their affairs and the requisition of documents. The Order also brings into force certain repeals which are consequential upon the other provisions brought into force.
