The Civil Jurisdiction and Judgments Act  
1982 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1986

1. This Order may be cited as the Civil Jurisdiction and Judgments Act 1982 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1986.

2. The provisions of the Civil Jurisdiction and Judgments Act 1982, to the extent that they are not already then in force, shall come into force on 1 January 1987.
