The Dinefwr (Communities) Order 1986

Made - - - - - 25th November 1986

Coming into operation —

For the purposes
described in
article 2(1) - - - - - 1st January 1987

For all other
purposes - - - - - 1st April 1987

Whereas the Local Government Boundary Commission for Wales, under paragraph 6 of Schedule 10 to the Local Government Act 1972 (a), made proposals to the Secretary of State for Wales in relation to communities in the Borough of Dinefwr:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of his powers under paragraph 7 of the said Schedule and section 67(4) and (5) of the said Act as applied by paragraph 9 of the said Schedule, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order giving effect to the said proposals with modifications:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Dinefwr (Communities) Order 1986.

2.—(1) 1st January 1987 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Regulations as modified by paragraph (2).

For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

(2) In the said regulation 4(1), item (e) shall not apply in relation to the constitution of any new community council.

Interpretation

3. In this order—

“the appointed day” means 1st April 1987;

“as altered” means as altered by the Ceredigion (Communities) Order 1986 (b) and the Carmarthen (Communities) Order 1986 (c);

“new community” means a community constituted by this order;

“new community council” means a community council established by this order;

“new community ward” means a community ward formed by this order;

“the Regulations” means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(a) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1978(b); and

“the Schedule” means the Schedule to this order.

The boundary map

4.—(1) In this order, “the boundary map” means the map issued by the Welsh Office and marked “Boundary map of the Dinefwr (Communities) Order 1986”. The sheets of the boundary map are respectively marked with the numbers 1 to 56.

(2) Regulation 5(3)(a)(ii) of the Regulations (which requires the supply of prints of maps referred to in orders to the Secretary of State for Social Services) shall not apply.

Communities

5. In the Borough of Dinefwr as altered—

(1) the seventeen communities of Ammanford, Cilycwm, Cynwyl Gaeo, Llanddeusant, Llandybie, Llanegwad, Llanfair-ar-y-bryn, Llanfihangel Aberbythych, Llanfynydd, Llangadog, Llangathen, Llansadwrn, Llansawel, Llanwrda, Myddfai, Quarter Bach and Talley shall continue;

(2) the seven existing communities of Betws, Cwmamman, Llandeilo, Llandeilofawr Rural, Llandingat Without, Llandovery and Llandyfeisant shall be abolished;

(3) six new communities to be known as Betws, Cwmamman, Ffairfach, Llandeilo, Llandovery and Manordeilo shall be constituted; and

(4) the communities named in paragraphs (1) and (3) shall consist of the areas shown by the relevant continuous red lines on the boundary map.

Community councils

6.—(1) The community council of any community named in paragraph (2) of article 5 shall be dissolved.

(2) The community wards of the communities of Ammanford, Betws, Llandeilofawr Rural, Llandybie, Llanegwad, Llanfihangel Aberbythych, Llangadog, Llangathen and Quarter Bach shall be abolished.

(3) There shall be a community council for each new community.

(4) From the appointed day to 11th May 1987 any person in office immediately before the appointed day in any office described in column (1) of the following table shall be a councillor of the community specified in respect thereof in column (2).

(5) As from 11th May 1987—

(a) the communities in respect of which new community wards are named in column (2) of the Schedule shall be divided into such wards, such wards consisting of the areas shown by the relevant continuous green lines on the boundary map;

(b) the number of councillors for the new community of Betws, and for each new community ward, shall be that shown in respect thereof in column (3) of the Schedule.

(6) Community councillors for the new community of Betws, and for the new community wards, shall be elected on 7th May 1987. The persons elected shall come into office on 11th May 1987 and shall retire on the fourth day after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 1991.

(7) The annual meetings of the new community councils for 1987 shall be convened by the officer appointed by the Borough Council of Dinewr for the purpose.

(8) As from 11th May 1987 the number of councillors for any community named in column (1) of the following table shall be that specified in respect of the community in column (2).

(9) Regulation 8(1) (Councillors) of the Regulations shall not apply to any community or community ward in the Borough of Dinefwr.

Petty sessional division

7. The Dinefwr petty sessional division shall consist of the Borough of Dinefwr as altered.

Residuary successors

8. In relation to any authority named in column (1) of the following table, for the purposes of any provision of the Regulations which refers to the residuary successor of a dissolved authority, the new community council specified in respect of the first-mentioned authority in column (2) is hereby specified as the residuary successor of such authority.

9.—(1) The specified papers of a community named in column (1) of the following table shall be deposited in the custody of the new community council named in respect of such community in column (2).

(2) The specified papers of a community named in column (1) of the following table shall be deposited in such custody as may, with the approval of the Borough Council of Dinefwr, be agreed between the community councils specified in respect of such community in column (2), or failing such approval and agreement, as may be directed by the said borough council.

(3) In this article, "specified papers", in relation to any community, means the public books, writings and papers of the community (including any photographic copies thereof) and all documents directed by law to be kept therewith.

Expenses of new community councils

10. In the year beginning on the appointed day the Borough Council of Dinefwr may levy rates in each new community and make payments to the new community council as if such council had issued a precept to the borough council requiring the payment of a sum not exceeding the product of a rate of 8p in the pound calculated on the total rateable value as set out in the valuation list on the appointed day.

Local Acts, orders and byelaws

11. The existing communities named in any entry in column (1) of the following table are hereby specified in relation to regulation 41(4) (Local Acts, orders and byelaws) of the Regulations and the new communities named in respect of such communities in column (2) are hereby specified in relation to such communities.

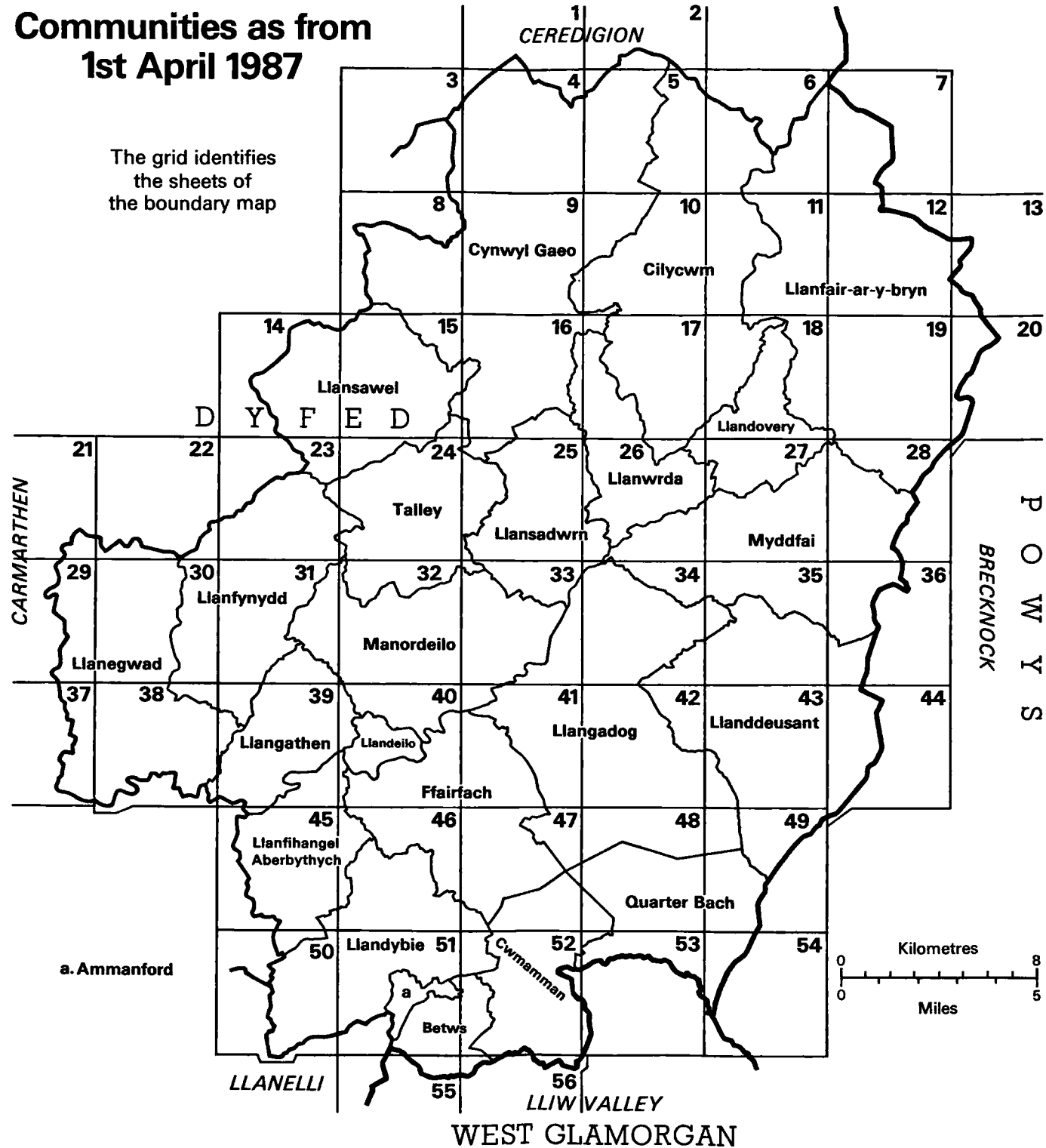

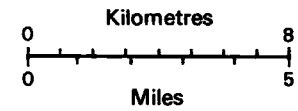
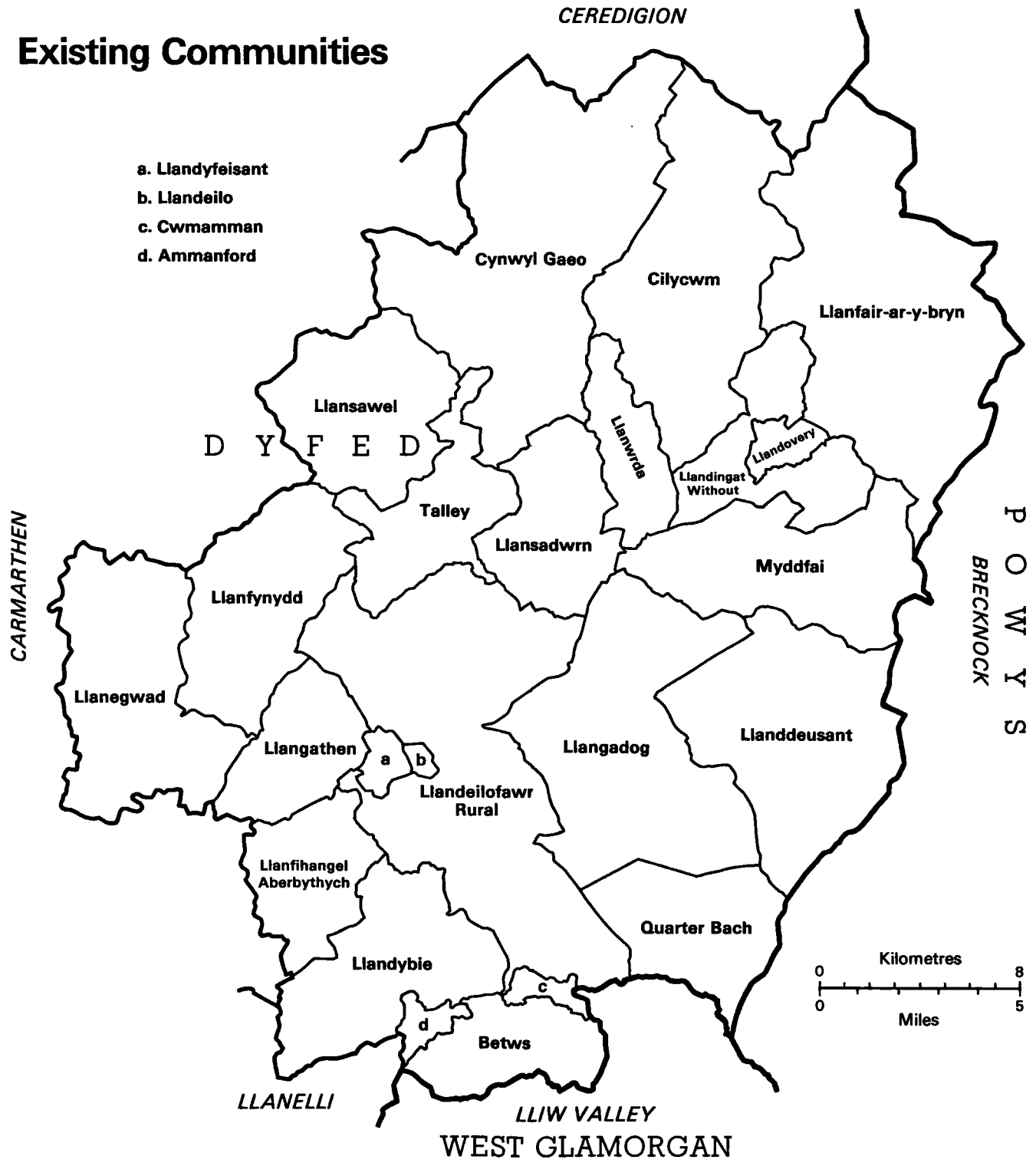
Communities as from 1st April 1987
