# The Winchester–Preston Trunk Road (A34) (Wytham Slip Road) Order 1986

Made	28th November 1986
Coming into Operation	29th December 1986

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 10 of the Highways Act  $1980(\mathbf{a})$ , and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The new highway which the Secretary of State proposes to construct along the route described in the Schedule to this Order shall become a trunk road as from the date when this Order comes into operation.

2. The centre line of the new trunk road is indicated by a heavy black line on the deposited plan.

3. In this Order:-

(1) measurements of distance are measured along the route of the relevant highway;

(2)	(i) "the deposited plan"	means the plan numbered RSE/4B/65/2/1 marked "The Winchester-Preston Trunk Road (A34) (Wytham Slip Road) Order 1986," signed by authority of the Secret- ary of State and deposited at the Depart- ment of Transport, Romney House, Mar- sham Street, London SW1P 3PY;
	(ii) "the new trunk road"	means the highway mentioned in article 1 of this Order; and

4. This Order shall come into operation on 29th December 1986 and may be cited as the Winchester-Preston Trunk Road (A34) (Wytham Slip Road) Order 1986.

#### THE SCHEDULE

#### ROUTE OF THE NEW TRUNK ROAD

The route of the new trunk road is at Wytham in the County of Oxford and is about 324 metres in length, starting at a point on the south eastern boundary of the highway from Botley Lodge to Wytham Village, 1.1 kilometres south of its junction with the road between Wytham Village and the A34 trunk road at the "Wytham Turn", and about 60 metres south east of Botley Lodge, then going generally in a south westerly direction and ending at a point on the northern boundary of the A420 trunk road 114 metres west of the A420/A34 Interchange (known as "Botley Interchange").
