BUILDING AND BUILDINGS

The Building (Amendment of Prescribed Fees) Regulations 1986

Made	17th December 1986
Laid before Parliament	9th January 1987
Coming into Operation	1st February 1987

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 1, 3, 16(10), 34, 35 and 50(3) of, and paragraphs 2, 5 and 10(c) of Schedule 1 to, the Building Act 1984(**a**), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Building (Amendment of Prescribed Fees) Regulations 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1987.

Amendment of the Building (Prescribed Fees etc.) Regulations 1985

2. The Building (Prescribed Fees etc.) Regulations 1985(b) are amended as follows:—

- (1) in regulation 2 -
 - (a) omit the definition of "material alteration",
 - (b) in the definition of "multiple work"—
 - (i) for "12(2)" substitute "12", and
 - (ii) after "13(3)" insert "of the principal regulations",
 - (c) in the definition of "small domestic building", after "to be used" insert "wholly", and
 - (d) in the definition of "work"—
 - (i) in paragraph (b), omit "material", and
 - (ii) omit paragraph (c).
- (2) in regulation 13
 - (a) in paragraph (2)(a), for "or/each" substitute "or each",
 - (b) in paragraph (2)(b)—
 - (i) for "paragraph (4)" substitute "paragraph (5)", and
 - (ii) for "the other estimates calculated under" substitute "all the estimates required by",
 - (c) in paragraph (6), for "(5)" substitute "(3)",

(3) in Schedule 1-

- (a) in paragraphs 2 and 5, for "£65" substitute "£75", and
- (b) in paragraph 6, after "building notice fee" insert "for each small domestic building", and
- (c) for Table 1 and Table 2 substitute the following Tables-

 - (b) for the Table, substitute the following Table-

(5) in Schedule 3 —

"5. In relation to work described in regulation 5(3) the building notice fee is the aggregate of the plan fee and the inspection fee which would have been payable had plans been deposited for the purposes of section 16 of the Act",

Transitional provisions

3. These regulations shall not affect the application of the Building (Prescribed Fees etc.) Regulations 1985 in relation to work in respect of which—

(1) a building notice was given or full plans were deposited (under regulation 11 of the Building Regulations 1985(a)), or

(2) an initial notice or a public body's notice was given (under section 47(1) or 54(1) of the Building Act 1984)

before 1st February 1987, notwithstanding that on a subsequent occasion a notice is or has been given, or plans are or have been deposited, in respect of substantially the same work.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations increase the fees payable to a local authority following-

- (a) the giving of building notices to or the deposit of full plans with the authority under regulation 11 of the Building Regulations 1985, or
- (b) work previously being supervised by an approved inspector (under Part II of the Building Act 1984 and the Building (Approved Inspectors etc.) Regulations 1985 (S.I. 1985/1066)) reverting to local authority control.

Regulation 2(3) and (4) amends the Building (Prescribed Fees etc.) Regulations 1985 so as to increase the flat rate fees in Schedule 1 to those Regulations by approximately 16% and those in Schedule 2 by 25%. The amendments effected by regulation 2(5)(c) increase the fees linked to the cost of works in Schedule 3 to the 1985 Regulations by approximately 12%.

Certain other minor amendments are made by the remainder of regulation 2 to correct minor drafting and printing errors in the 1985 regulations.

Transitional provisions are contained in regulation 3.
