**The London-Portsmouth Trunk Road A3
(Footbridges at Deerbarn, Guildford) Order 1986**

Made - - - - - 23rd December 1986

Coming into Operation 6th February 1987

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 10 of the Highways Act 1980(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers:—

1.—(1) The new footways which the Secretary of State proposes to construct along the routes described in the Schedule to this Order shall become trunk roads as from the date when this Order comes into operation.

(2) The centre lines of those new footways are indicated by heavy black lines on the plan numbered DSE/5076/09/TR6/T066 marked “The London-Portsmouth Trunk Road A3 (Footbridges at Deerbarn, Guildford) Order 1986” signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of Transport, Romney House, Marsham Street, London SW1P 3PY;

2. This order shall come into operation on 6th February 1987 and may be cited as the London-Portsmouth Trunk Road A3 (Footbridges at Deerbarn, Guildford) Order 1986.

SCHEDULE

ROUTE OF THE NEW FOOTWAYS

The routes of the new footways are routes at Deerbarn, Guildford in the County of Surrey as follows:—

(1) a route about 25 metres in length, starting on the southern end of the western parapet to the existing railway bridge, then going generally northwards and ending at the northern end of the western parapet; and

(2) a route about 25 metres in length, starting on the southern end of the eastern parapet to the existing railway bridge, then going generally northwards and ending at the northern end of the eastern parapet.
