The Fixed Penalty (Increase) Order 1986

In exercise of the power conferred upon me by paragraph 4(2) of Schedule 12 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Fixed Penalty (Increase) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 17th February 1986.

(2) The Fixed Penalty (Increase) Order 1982(b) is hereby revoked.

(3) This Order shall extend to England and Wales only.

2. The fixed penalty referred to in paragraph 4(1) of Schedule 12 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 shall in all cases be £12.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order provides in England and Wales for an increase from £10 to £12 in the fixed penalty in respect of offences to which paragraph 2 of Schedule 12 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 applies (offences in connection with lights, reflectors, obstruction, etc.) for which a person is liable on summary conviction to be fined £100 or more. This Order does not affect Scotland.
