## The Registered Designs (Fees) Rules 1986

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 36 and 40 of the Registered Designs Act 1949 (a) and now vested in him (b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf and with the consent of the Treasury pursuant to the said section 40, hereby makes the following Rules:

1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Registered Designs (Fees) Rules 1986 and shall come into operation as respects Rules 1(1), 2 and 4 on 21st April 1986 and as respects Rules 1(2) and 3 on 26th May 1986.

(2) Rule 3 of and Schedule 1 to the Designs Rules 1984 (c) and the Designs (Amendment) Rules 1985 (d) are hereby revoked.

2. These Rules shall be construed as one with the Designs Rules 1984.

3. The fees to be paid in respect of any matters arising under the Registered Designs Act 1949 shall be those specified in the Schedule to these Rules; and in any case where a form specified in the Schedule as the corresponding form in relation to any matter is required by the Designs Rules 1984 to be used, that form shall be accompanied by the fee specified in respect of that matter.

4. Where on or after 21st April 1986 but before 26th May 1986 an application is made for an extension of the period of copyright in any registered design in respect of which the period of copyright is due to expire on or after 26th May 1986, the fee payable on such application shall be that which would be payable if the application were made on or after 26th May 1986 and Rules 1(2) and 3 above had come into operation.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Rules.)*

These Rules replace the provision for fees contained in the Designs Rules 1984 with self-contained provision. Fees are increased with effect from 26th May 1986, except in the case of fees paid in advance for the extension of the period of copyright in a design for any period beginning on or after 26th May 1986, which are increased with effect from 21st April 1986. It is estimated that the total amount of fees collected per annum at the new levels will be six per cent greater than the amount collected per annum at the existing levels.
