PUBLIC RECORDS

The Public Record Office (Fees) Regulations 1986

Made - - - - - 10th April 1986
Coming into Force 1st May 1986

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(5) of the Public Records Act 1958(a) and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Record Office (Fees) Regulations 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1986.

2.—(1) Subject to the following provisions, the fees to be charged for the authentication of copies of or extracts from records under the charge of the Keeper of Public Records and for other services afforded by officers of the Public Record Office shall be those set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

(2) For the purpose of reimbursing the Keeper of Public Records in respect of value added tax payable on the supply of services to which a fee (other than a fee payable in respect of item 1 in the Schedule) relates, there shall be charged an additional fee equal to the amount of such tax, and the incidence of the first-mentioned fee shall determine the incidence of the additional fee.

(3) The Keeper of Public Records may remit a fee or part of a fee where the service performed by him is likely to include any research in consequence of a postal inquiry or has been or is likely to be exceptionally simple.

3. The Public Record Office (Fees) Regulations 1977(b) are hereby revoked.

<i>Research</i> 3. For any piece of research among the records in the Public Record Office undertaken in consequence of a postal inquiry	10.00
