The Hill Farming (Appointed Day for Repeal) Order 1986

Made - - - - *14th April 1986*

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food in relation to England and Northern Ireland, the Secretary of State for Scotland in relation to Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales in relation to Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 113(3) of, and Part II of Schedule 5 to, the Agriculture Act 1970(a) and now vested in them(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Hill Farming (Appointed Day for Repeal) Order 1986.

2. The date from which the repeal of the enactments mentioned in Part II of Schedule 5 to the Agriculture Act 1970 shall, to the extent specified in the third column of that Part, take effect shall be 1st May 1986.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order appoints 1st May 1986 as the day for the repeal of various provisions relating to hill farming which are listed in Part II of Schedule 5 to the Agriculture Act 1970. Those provisions were repealed prospectively by the 1970 Act consequential on section 35 of that Act (termination of grants under section 1 of the Hill Farming Act 1946 (c.73)).
