BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES**The Gaming (Bingo) Act (Fees) Order 1986**

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	8th May 1986
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	19th May 1986
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	9th June 1986

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by paragraph 5(1) of the Schedule to the Gaming (Bingo) Act 1985(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Gaming (Bingo) Act (Fees) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 9th June 1986.

(2) In this Order “the Act” means the Gaming (Bingo) Act 1985 and “the Board” means the Gaming Board for Great Britain.

2. There shall be payable to the Board in respect of a certificate of approval issued under paragraph 1 of the Schedule to the Act the following fees:

- (a) for the issue of the certificate, a fee of £33,000; and
- (b) for the continuing in force of the certificate for each period of three years, a fee of £30,000 payable first on the third anniversary of the date on which the certificate came into force and subsequently at intervals of three years thereafter.

3. A certificate of approval issued under paragraph 1 of the Schedule to the Act shall terminate if the fee mentioned in paragraph (b) of Article 2 above is not paid to the Board as required by that paragraph.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order requires the payment of fees in respect of the issue of and continuing in force of a certificate of approval by the Gaming Board for Great Britain to an organiser of games of multiple bingo under the Schedule to the Gaming (Bingo) Act 1985. That Act comes into force on 9th June 1986 (S.I. 1986/832).

The fees specified are an issue fee of £33,000 and a periodical fee of £30,000 payable every three years thereafter.
