**The Motor Vehicles (Tests) (Amendment) (No. 2)
Regulations 1986**

Made - - - 29th May 1986

Laid before Parliament 9th June 1986

Coming into Operation 1st July 1986

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 43(2) and (6) of the Road Traffic Act 1972(a), and now vested in him (b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with section 199(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Tests) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1986.

2. The Motor Vehicles (Tests) Regulations 1981(c) are hereby amended so that in the regulations specified in column 1 of the Table below for the amounts specified in column 2 of that Table there are substituted the amounts specified in column 3 of the Table.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Motor Vehicles (Tests) Regulations 1981 so that:—

- (i) the fee payable for the examination of a motor cycle not having a side car attached to it is increased from £6.40 to £7.10;
- (ii) the fee payable for the examination of any other vehicle (not being a vehicle in Class VI) is increased from £10.70 to £11.90; and
- (iii) the fee for the supply of 100 forms of test certificate is increased from £23 to £27.
