The Rampton Hospital Board (Establishment and Constitution) Order 1986

Made - - - 5th June 1986

Laid before Parliament 10th June 1986

Coming into Operation 1st July 1986

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of powers conferred on him by section 11 of the National Health Service Act 1977(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Rampton Hospital Board (Establishment and Constitution) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1986.

Establishment of the Rampton Hospital Board

2. There is hereby established a special health authority which shall be known as the Rampton Hospital Board (hereinafter in this Order referred to as "the Board").

Functions of the Board

3. The Board shall exercise such functions relating to the management of the special hospital known as Rampton Hospital as the Secretary of State may by regulations direct it to perform on his behalf.

Constitution

4. The Board shall consist of a chairman and not more than 7 members.
