**The Exeter Airport Shops Order 1986**

*Made* - - - 3rd June 1986

*Coming into Operation* 16th June 1986

Whereas it appears to the Secretary of State that Exeter Airport is an airport at which there is a substantial amount of international passenger traffic:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1(2) of the Shops (Airports) Act 1962(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Exeter Airport Shops Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 16th June 1986.

2. Exeter Airport is hereby designated for the purposes of the Shops (Airports) Act 1962 as being an airport at which there appears to the Secretary of State to be a substantial amount of international passenger traffic.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

The Shops (Airports) Act 1962 exempts traders at airports designated for the purposes of the Act as being airports at which there appears to the Secretary of State to be a substantial amount of international passenger traffic from the provisions of Part I of the Shops Act 1950 (c.28), which relate to hours of closing. By this Order the Secretary of State designates Exeter Airport as such an airport.
