PUBLIC PASSENGER VEHICLES**The Public Service Vehicles (Operators' Licences)
(Amendment) Regulations 1986**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers contained in sections 18(3)(a) and 59 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981(a), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with section 61(2) of that Act(b), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Vehicles (Operators' Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 1986 and shall come into operation on 10th July 1986.

Amendment of Regulations

2. The Public Service Vehicles (Operators' Licences) Regulations 1981(c) shall be further amended in accordance with the following provisions of these Regulations.

3. In regulation 6—

- (1) in paragraph (1)(v)(a), the word “sitting”, and
- (2) in paragraph (3), the words “public sitting”, shall be deleted, and the word “inquiry” substituted.

4. In regulation 8(1), sub-paragraph (c) shall be deleted and the following substituted—

“(c) the words “Public Service Vehicle Operator's Identity Disc” or “Public Service Vehicle Operator's Disc”.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
