LICENSING (LIQUOR)

The Liquor Licensing (Fees) (Scotland) Order 1987

Made--24th September 1987Coming into force1st January 1988

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 8(1) and 135 of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 1976(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Fees) (Scotland) Order 1987 and shall come into force on 1st January 1988.

(2) In this Order "the Act" means the Licensing (Scotland) Act 1976.

2. The fee payable by any applicant to a licensing board in respect of any matter described in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order and arising under the provision of the Act specified in column 2 of that Schedule shall be the amount specified in the corresponding entry in column 3 thereof.

3. The Liquor Licensing (Fees) (Scotland) Order 1977(b) is revoked.
