The Local Statutory Provisions (Postponement of Repeal) (Scotland) Order 1987

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 225(6)(b) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 (1), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Statutory Provisions (Postponement of Repeal) (Scotland) Order 1987 and shall come into force on 31st December 1987.

2. The date on which all local statutory provisions applying to the whole or any part of the local government areas specified in the Schedule to this Order, so far as they apply, are to cease to have effect is hereby postponed to 31st December 1988.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

Section 225(6) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 as amended provides that all local statutory provisions to which the subsection applies shall cease to have effect at the end of 1984. Previous Orders (S.I.1984/1926, 1985/1629 and 1986/2034) have postponed until the end of 1987 the date on which all local statutory provisions applying to the local government areas or parts thereof listed in the Schedules to those Orders were to cease to have effect. This Order further postpones that date until the end of 1988 in respect of those local government areas listed in the Schedule to this Order.
