The Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986
(Commencement No. 2) Order 1987

Made - - - - 25th February 1987

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 46 of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986⁽¹⁾, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1987.
2. The provisions of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986 (other than Part V and section 30), insofar as they are not already in force, shall come into force on 1st April 1987.
