**The Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986 (Commencement  
No. 2) Order 1987**

*Made* - - - - *25th February 1987*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 46 of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986<sup>(a)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1987.
2. The provisions of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986 (other than Part V and section 30), insofar as they are not already in force, shall come into force on 1st April 1987.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This Order brings into force on 1st April 1987 all the provisions of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986 which are not already in force, except for Part V (which relates to the employment of solicitors by the Scottish Legal Aid Board) and section 30 (which makes special provision for legal aid in contempt proceedings).
