The Court of Session etc. Fees Amendment Order 1987

Made - - - - - *13th January 1987*

Laid before Parliament *30th January 1987*

Coming into force *23rd February 1987*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Courts of Law Fees (Scotland) Act 1895(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Court of Session etc. Fees Amendment Order 1987 and shall come into force on 23rd February 1987.

2. In Part I of the Table of Fees in the Schedule to the Court of Session etc. Fees Order 1984(b) the following amendments shall be made:—

(a) for the entry in column 1 of item C1 there shall be substituted the following:—

“1. Petition of whatever nature presented to Inner or Outer House other than a petition under item C2 of this table, whether in respect of the first or any subsequent step of process, and any application for registration or recognition of a judgment from a Contracting State under the Civil Jurisdiction and Judgments Act 1982(c) — inclusive fee”;

(b) for the entry in column 1 of item G4 there shall be substituted the following:—

“4. Certificate under the Judgments Extension Act 1868(d) or under the Civil Jurisdiction and Judgments Act 1982”.
